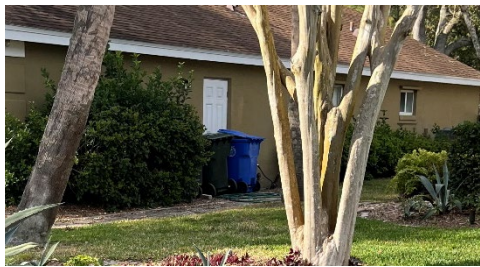

 3. Color Book – The color book is still in progress but nearing completion.
 4. Front Entrance lighting status – no progress.
 5. Repair of well pump – budget has been allocated and will be scheduled for repair.
 6. Faded street signs – The City of Oviedo will be contacted to determine if they can change the signs.
 7. Retention Ponds – The City of Oviedo has been contacted and they have scheduled mowing for twice each year.
 8. Sidewalks – The City of Oviedo has been contacted and made aware of the numerous damaged sidewalks. They indicate that a difference of ¼ in in height requires action on their part.
